

-196 SEPT BRAND AMBASSADOR COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions, and agreed to be bound by them, when entering this Promotion.

Promoter:

The Promoter is Lucozade Ribena Suntory Limited whose registered office is Building 1, ARC Uxbridge, Sanderson Road, Uxbridge UB8 1DH.

Who may enter:

1. This competition (the “**Promotion**”) is open to residents of the United Kingdom aged 18+ or over.
2. Employees (or family members of employees) of any group company of the Promoter, companies associated with the Promotion and all affiliates of such companies may not enter this Promotion.

How to enter:

Use of your Entry:

18.
